The Purpose of the Government Finance Officers Association of Oklahoma (GFOAO)

- To promote the use of efficient financial management systems by governmental organizations within the State of Oklahoma;
- To improve the knowledge and skills of all individuals concerned with government finance;
- To promote the orderly development of accounting, budgeting, and financial reporting procedures in cooperation with the **Government Finance Officers Association of the United States and Canada**, the National Council on Government Accounting, the Governmental Accounting Standards Board, and all other organizations established with similar goals; and
- To provide a forum for the discussion and analysis of financial problems arising under the laws of the United States, the State of Oklahoma, local

charters and ordinances and other subjects of mutual concern to public finance officials.

Promoting and Improving the Knowledge and Skills of Government Accounting

Each year the GFOAO joins with the Oklahoma Municipal Clerks, Treasurers and Finance Officers Association (OMCTFOA) and the Oklahoma Association of Public Treasurer's of the United States and Canada (OAPT US&C) in putting together sessions and speakers for the annual OMCTFOA conference held in October. The GFOAO normally sponsors three or more sessions as well as providing financial support to the OMCTFOA for the conference.

In addition to the annual conference, GFOAO works with the OAPT US&C to bring additional workshops to their members and other employees of its members. Past workshops have included Revenue Collection, Investment Policies, and Cash Handling. Each of these qualified as eligible courses toward

certification as a Certified Municipal Finance Administrator.

Membership

The GFOA of Oklahoma Executive Board consists of the following officers elected by the membership: President, First Vice President, Second Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, One Year Board Member, Two Year Board Member, and Three Year Board Member. The immediate past president also serves as a voting member of the Executive Board. A State Representative is elected by the GFOAO membership.

GFOAO membership consist of individuals employed by the State of Oklahoma or any political subdivision (cities, towns, counties) in the field of finance, accounting, or other related areas of fiscal management.

Associate membership is offered to individuals who have an interest in governmental finance and may include, but not limited to auditors, educators, bankers, actuaries, and bond counsels. Associate
